2009 SILVERADO PARADE – CALISTOGA

SATURDAY, JULY 4TH – 11:00 A.M.

1. **THE NUMBER OF PARADE ENTRIES IS LIMITED TO 80. LATE ENTRIES ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND PARTICIPATION WITHOUT A PRE-APPROVED ENTRY FORM IS PROHIBITED.**
(Acceptance of entries is at the discretion of the parade committee. You will be notified ONLY if your entry is NOT accepted.)
2. When completing the entry form, please list the class number, type of entry, and **a description for the announcer to read** as you pass the judging stand.
3. A check-in table will be located at the corner of Berry and Cedar Streets. A representative of your group is required to check in there and pick up your entry number no later than 10:30 a.m. If you do not check in by 10:30 a.m. your entry will be removed from the line up.
4. The parade starts at 11:00 a.m. at the corner of Lincoln Avenue and Cedar Street and proceeds down Lincoln to Fairway; down Fairway to the Fairgrounds. The Judging Stand is located on the corner of Lincoln and Washington Streets.

ALL ENTRIES will turn left at the Fairgrounds – on to Oak Street and return to the lineup area. All entries are requested to remain in line to the point of disbanding.
For insurance purposes, **ENTRIES ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
5. No objects may be thrown or handed out of any unit in the parade and no water may be thrown or sprayed from entrants. Failure to obey this rule may lead to removal from the parade.
6. In order to present a more uniform and entertaining parade to spectators, Parade Contestants are asked to limit their time spent in front of the judge’s stand to not more than 30 seconds. A penalty may be applied for time exceeding the 30 seconds.
7. Spacing is extremely important. Adequate space must be kept between entries throughout the entire parade route. Points may be deducted for inadequate spacing. Allowing a large gap between your entry and the entry in front or behind you may be grounds for disqualification.
8. The decisions by the judges will be final. No prize will be awarded if, in the opinion of the judges, the entry does not merit an award.
9. Parade results will be announced at 3:30 p.m. at the Fiesta Center on the Fairgrounds.
